

| 6 | 2. Harold  | RING U_                | Badge worn on the hat by diggers since WWI. See the circle of bayonets and crown.   |
| 7 |            | BUGL□                  | Used to play 'Reveille' and the 'Last Post.' 'Reveille' starts the day - the 'Last Post' ends it.   |
| 8 | 2. Garden  |                        | Grew wild at Gallipoli. Symbol of remembrance. Helps students memory too - smell it!  |
| 9 |            | PP  ES                 | Grew on the battle fields The red is a symbol of the blood of soldiers killed.  |
|   |            | Gallipoli Pine         | Free Woody clue. This pine was grown from the seed of the pine growing at Gallipoli. Read the story of the pine while you are there. Tick you've seen it. |
